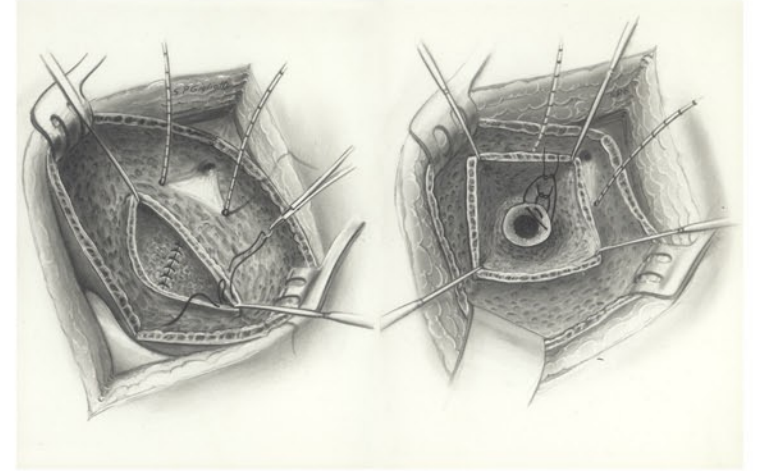
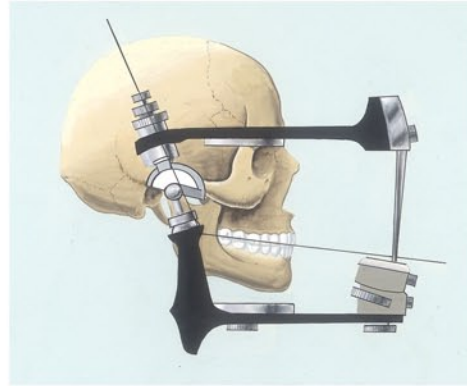




Steven Peter Gigliotti
